

STATE TRAINING PROVIDERS — FEDERAL FUNDING

4106. Mr F.M. Logan to the Minister for Training and Workforce Development:

I refer to the provision of Federal funds under the *National Partnership Agreement on Skills Reform* to Registered Training Organisations (RTO) via the State Government and I ask:

- (a) can the Minister please outline for each financial year from 2012-2013 onwards:
  - (i) how much federal funding has been provided to each State Training Provider; and
  - (ii) how much federal funding has been provided to each private RTO?

**Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:**

- (a) (i)–(ii) The training delivery component of Commonwealth funding for the National Partnership Agreement on Skills Reform supplements other Commonwealth and State recurrent funding for training delivery and is treated as part of general training funds. Specific allocations are not provided to State Training Providers or private RTOs.

The National Partnership funding for each of the years in question was as follows:

2012–13	\$24.8 million
2013–14	\$24.8 million
2014–15	\$39.3 million
