

BARBAGALLO RACEWAY — MINISTERIAL MEETINGS

81. Hon AARON STONEHOUSE to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Sport and Recreation:

I thank the minister for his reply to my question without notice 8 of 13 March 2018 about his meetings with the “We Need Our Track Back” group, and the return of motorcycling to the Barbagallo Raceway. I specifically refer to the meeting at Dumas House on 30 January.

- (1) Who was present at that meeting, and in what capacity did they attend?
- (2) What agenda items, if any, were discussed during the course of that meeting?
- (3) What follow-up actions, if any, were undertaken by the minister and/or his senior staff in the days immediately following the meeting?
- (4) Are any further meetings scheduled; and, if so, for what date or dates?
