 - (5) What treatment assets are used between Wellington Dam, Harvey Water and Alcoa's facilities?
 - (6) What storage units are used between Wellington Dam, Harvey Water and Alcoa's facilities?
 - (7) What other pipes, treatment assets and storage exist in the Harris and Wellington catchments?
