**519. Hon JIM CHOWN to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:**

- (1) How many reviews, inquiries and reports does the government currently have underway both at a departmental and ministerial level?
- (2) Please list the titles of each review, inquiry and report, and the body undertaking them.
- (3) Please list the commencement and reporting date and the entity they report to.

**Hon SUE ELLERY replied:**
