

**KINGSLEY — NOISE POLLUTION**

*Petition*

**MRS J.M.C. STOJKOVSKI (Kingsley)** [12.02 pm]: I have a petition that has been certified by the Clerk from 46 petitioners in the following terms —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned residents of Western Australia are concerned about the increase in noise levels in the north-west area of the suburb of Kingsley. We believe that noise pollution in this area has increased to unacceptable levels, due to an increase in the volume of traffic from trains on the Joondalup line, and motor vehicles using the Mitchell Freeway. We are aware that the noise levels have a negative impact on daily activity and enjoyment of the area.

We respectfully ask the Legislative Assembly to authorise the relevant authority to build a noise barrier adjacent to the Whitfords Train Station and Mitchell Freeway, on the Eastern side, along the southbound Mitchell Freeway on-ramp from Whitfords Avenue.
