

OUTPATIENT NON-ESSENTIAL MEDICAL CARE — FEE

- (1) What is the cost recovery level for an outpatient appointment at a public hospital for non-essential medical care?
- (2) Is the cost recovery level for an outpatient appointment at a public hospital for non-essential medical care the same at every public hospital; and, if not, why not?
- (3) What is the average cost recovery level for an outpatient appointment at a public hospital for the purposes of undergoing an annual medical check in order to acquire a medical certificate to retain the right to drive?
- (4) What is the average cost recovery level for an outpatient appointment at Derby Hospital for the purpose of undergoing an annual medical check in order to acquire a medical certificate to retain the right to drive?
