

**GOLDEN BAY — HOUSING DEVELOPMENT**

*Petition*

**MR P. PAPALIA (Warnbro)** [2.54 pm]: I have a petition bearing 444 signatures that is certified as complying with standing orders. It reads —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say that the Barnett government's proposed housing development at Golden Bay is opposed on the following grounds:

- a. The proposed density of housing is inconsistent with existing urban character of surrounding suburbs,
- b. The proposed broad scale application of medium density does not integrate with prevailing context of the locality,
- c. The proposed ratio of social housing is too high and does not accord with surrounding suburbs,
- d. There has been no provision for the following services to meet demand from the proposed increase in population:
  - (1) A local police station,
  - (2) A Golden Bay primary school (land has been allocated but no funding for construction),
  - (3) Enhanced recreational facilities like Australian football at Lark Hill Sports Complex, and
  - (4) Improved public transport including a train station at Paganoni Road in Karnup.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to call on the Barnett government to reconsider its proposed Golden Bay development in light of these community concerns.
