

PERTH AIRPORT PLAN

415. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to question on notice 771.

- (1) Is the minister aware I was asking for the data used in the draft Public Transport Plan for Perth 2031, not the data for the final plan?
- (2) Considering the draft plan has been publicly released, why is the minister unwilling to now release this data?
- (3) Will the minister now reconsider his position and release the data used to develop the draft plan?
- (4) If no to (3), why not?
