

PUBLIC HOUSING — VACANT PROPERTIES — SOUTH EAST METROPOLITAN REGION

820. Hon SAMANTHA ROWE to the Minister for Housing:

- (1) How many public housing properties are currently vacant in the south east metropolitan region?
- (2) Of those vacant properties, how many are vacant for each of the following reasons: refurbishment or maintenance between tenancies, awaiting occupation by new tenants, awaiting sale or demolition prior to redevelopment, and allocation to the management of community housing groups?
- (3) Will the minister provide a breakdown of these properties' locations by suburb?
