

PREMIER — BUSINESS CASE ACCESS

1795. Hon Martin Aldridge to the Leader of the House representing the Premier; Minister for Public Sector Management; Federal–State Relations:

I refer to Legislative Council question on notice No. 1664, in relation to the provision of business cases and the ‘Inquiry into Government Programs and Projects,’ and I ask:

- (a) (a) who notified agencies to provide business cases to the special inquirer;
- (b) (b) on what basis or law were agencies directed to comply;
- (c) (c) please provide a copy of the ‘notification’ to agencies directing them to provide business cases;
- (d) (d) please provide a list of business cases supplied to the Special Inquirer; and
- (e) (e) did all agencies comply with the ‘notification’?
