

MINISTER FOR WOMEN'S INTERESTS — FEMALE SENIOR EXECUTIVE SERVICE WORKERS

475. Hon PETER COLLIER to the minister representing the Minister for Women's Interests:

- (1) How many female senior executive service workers have left positions within each of the minister's portfolios since 11 March 2017?
- (2) What are the names and the positions of those senior executive service workers referred to in (1)?

- (1) Five since 11 March 2017.
- (2) The names and positions are as follows: Jennifer Mathews, director general; Emma White, director general; Amanda Gadsdon; executive director, aboriginal engagement and coordination; Julieanne Davis, executive director, country services and therapeutic care; and Sandra van Soelen, director, working with children screening unit. Julieanne Davis announced her resignation prior to the machinery-of-government changes; however, she did not leave her position until after 17 March 2017.
