

MIDLAND TRAIN STATION — RELOCATION

6189. Hon Alison Xamon to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport

I refer to the answer to question on notice No. 5652 of 11 September 2012 regarding moving the Midland train station, and I ask —

- (1) Has any planning been undertaken towards moving the Midland train station closer to the Midland Health Campus?
- (2) If yes to (1), please specify the planning that has been done?
- (3) Will any funding be nominated in future budget years towards any of the following for moving the train station towards the Midland Health Campus —
  - (a) a feasibility study;
  - (b) design work;
  - (c) construction ; and
  - (d) any other costs?
- (4) If yes to (3) (a–d), please specify how much and when?
- (5) Has any planning been undertaken towards moving the Midland train station to the south, in line with the recommendations of the *Midland 2017 Enquiry by Design* report?
- (6) If yes to (5), please specify the planning that has been done?
- (7) Will any funding be nominated in future budget years towards any of the following for moving the train station to the south? If yes, please specify how much for —
  - (a) a feasibility study;
  - (b) design work;
  - (c) construction ; and
  - (d) any other costs?
