

URANIUM MINING — BAN

Petition

MR C.J. TALLENTIRE (Gosnells) [12.03 pm]: I have two petitions to table. The first petition relates to the reinstatement of the ban on uranium mining in Western Australia. It has been certified as conforming to the standing orders of the house, and has been signed by 745 petitioners. It reads —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the **Legislative Assembly** of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to uranium mining.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to recognise the unacceptable risk to the community and the environment posed by uranium mining and to immediately re-instate the ban on uranium mining in Western Australia.
