

ALBANY HIGHWAY–NICHOLSON ROAD INTERSECTION — CRASHES

5537. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport

I refer to the intersection of Albany Highway and Nicholson Road and ask —

- (1) How many accidents occurred at this intersection due to drivers failing to stop at a red light in —
 - (a) 2010;
 - (b) 2011; and
 - (c) 2012?
- (2) Has this intersection been identified as one where drivers repeatedly run red lights?
- (3) If yes to (2), what action does Main Roads plan to take to address this issue?
- (4) If no to (2), will Main Roads undertake any monitoring of this intersection, and if yes when will this occur?
- (5) Are road works planned for this intersection, and if yes —
 - (a) what works are planned;
 - (b) when will works commence; and
 - (c) what will be the cost of works?
