420. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer to the answer given to question without notice 398 asked yesterday about the minister's press release titled "Schooling reforms to give every student an opportunity for a better future", dated 2 May 2019.

- (1) Will the minister advise which stakeholders participated in a face-to-face consultation and those who were consulted by telephone?
- (2) Will the minister table all documentation provided to stakeholders by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority as part of the consultation on the proposed reform?

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) All the stakeholders listed in the response to question without notice 398 initially participated in face-to-face consultation. Further informal follow-up to some of those meetings was conducted by telephone.
- (2) No. I can provide most of the documentation provided to stakeholders. However, SCSA has advised me not to table one document that includes commercial information on enrolments of private registered training organisations. I table the attached documents.
