

PLANNING — STATE PLANNING POLICY 5.4 ROAD AND RAIL NOISE

4044. Mrs L.M. Harvey to the Minister for Planning:

I refer to the review of State Planning Policy 5.4 – Road and Rail Noise, and I ask:

- (a) on what date did the review commence;
- (b) on what date did submissions close;
- (c) has the Minister received advice from the WA Planning Commission including recommendations on changes to State Planning Policy 5.4;
- (d) if yes to (c) when did the Minister receive the advice and what changes were recommended by the WA Planning Commission and will the Minister table the advice;
- (e) has the Minister received advice from the Department of Planning including recommendations on changes to State Planning Policy 5.4; and
- (f) if yes to (e) when did the Minister receive the advice and what changes were recommended by the Department of Planning and will the Minister table the advice?

Ms R. Saffioti replied:

- (a) July 2015.
- (b) 15 December 2017 (after a 3 month advertising period).
- (c)–(f) Once the Western Australian Planning Commission has considered State Planning Policy 5.4, the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage will provide advice to the Minister in relation to the recommendations as required.
