

FORESTRY — REGROWTH KARRI

3420. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Forestry:  
Regarding the thinning of regrowth karri, for the year 2014:

- (a) how many cubic metres of extracted logs were:
  - (i) karri; and
  - (ii) other (please specify);
- (b) how much of the volume was:
  - (i) first and second grade karri sawlogs;
  - (ii) other grade karri sawlogs (please specify);
  - (iii) karri chips logs;
  - (iv) first and second grade marri sawlogs;
  - (v) other grade marri sawlogs (please specify); and
  - (vi) marri chip logs; and
- (c) what was the volume estimated to be available of:
  - (i) first and second grade karri sawlogs;
  - (ii) other grade karri sawlogs; and
  - (iii) karri chip logs?

**Hon Ken Baston replied:**

The following statistics apply to log removals from thinning operations conducted during 2014 in areas of regrowth karri regenerated since 1967. Harvesting operations conducted in the older regrowth stands (regenerated prior to 1967) may contain a mixture of thinning and other objectives for which log removals are not recorded separately.

- (a) (i) 39 776 cubic metres
  - (ii) 259 cubic metres of marri
  - (b) (i) Nil
  - (ii) 3 651 cubic metres of third grade sawlogs and karri laminated veneer logs
  - (iii) 36 125 cubic metres
  - (iv-v) Nil
  - (vi) 259 cubic metres
  - (c) (i - ii) Nil
  - (iii) 38 400 cubic metres
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
