

CONSERVATION COMMISSION — STAFF

1992. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

With regard to the Conservation Commission, I ask:

- (a) what was the rate of staff absenteeism in the Conservation Commission in 2012–2013;
- (b) how many officers in the agency have been granted study leave in the past twelve months and for what total amount of time;
- (c) have there been any reported instances of theft, fraud or corruption by staff since 1 July 2012, and if so, how many and what were the circumstances;
- (d) how many complaints of sexual harassment, bullying or intimidation have been lodged by staff since 1 July 2012; and
- (e) as at 1 July 2013 how many full-time equivalent positions were not filled?

**Mr A.P. Jacob replied:**

- (a) The personal leave rate (which includes sick leave and carers leave) was 3.8 per cent.
- (b) One officer was granted study leave for a total of five days.
