5540. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport

 - (b) Audits are part of the Public Transport Authority's (PTA) Safety Management System which is a requirement of the PTA's rail safety accreditation. The PTA is audited annually by the Office of Rail Safety to ensure the PTA complies with all requirements.
 - (c) Audits are conducted by various PTA personnel who have received audit training.
