

SCHOOLS — STUDENT-CENTRED FUNDING MODEL — BASE ALLOCATION

4224. Hon Sue Ellery to the Minister for Education:

Under the Student-Centred Funding Model for the enrolment linked base component, please detail the funding allocation for:

- (a) kindergarten;
- (b) pre-primary to year three;
- (c) years four to six;
- (d) years seven to ten; and
- (e) years 11 and 12?

Hon Peter Collier replied:

- (a)–(e) The enrolment-linked base is not allocated based on student year levels. The enrolment-linked base allocation is provided to ensure schools are able to meet general operating costs.

The allocation depends on the type of school and the size of the student population. The allocation reduces to zero once the per-student funding generates sufficient funding to meet general operating costs.
