

ABORIGINAL AFFAIRS — REGIONAL SERVICES REFORM UNIT — ROEBOURNE

1196. Hon Robin Chapple to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Community Services:

- (1) Has the Western Australian Government, through the Regional Services Reform Unit, provided the Roebourne Community with a full list of who has received funding, how much funding and for what purpose?
- (2) If no to (1), why not and when will it be provided?
- (3) Is the Minister aware that this delay in providing information has caused a lack of clarity among community groups of how services and programs can be accessed?

**Hon Sue Ellery replied:**

- (1) Yes – The Regional Services Reform Unit provided the Roebourne community, through the Roebourne 6718 Advantage Plan group secretariat, with full details of government-related service funding and outcome data as they relate to Roebourne and surrounding communities, via email, in March 2017.

In addition, the Reform Unit published expenditure and outcomes mapping data for the Kimberley and Pilbara regions, including Roebourne, in October 2017.
