

STATE INTEGRATED PUBLIC TRANSPORT STRATEGY

821. Hon ALISON XAMON to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to question without notice 1181 asked on 24 November 2009 to which the minister advised that the state integrated public transport strategy would be completed at around the same time as the WA Planning Commission's report "Directions 2031".

- (1) What is the current status of the state integrated public transport strategy?
- (2) When will the minister release the strategy for public consultation and stakeholder engagement?
- (3) Which specific stakeholder groups have been identified for engagement?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The independent panel is still finalising the 2031 public transport network plan.
- (2) The public transport strategy will be released for public consultation after the government has considered the final report.
- (3) A range of stakeholder groups will be included in a public consultation process.
