

MINISTERIAL OFFICES — HOSPITALITY AND OTHER BENEFITS ACCEPTANCE

1713. Mr M. McGowan to the Minister for Police; Tourism; Road Safety; Women's Interests:

Has any officer or placement within the Minister's office accepted any hospitality, invitation to an event, free accommodation or free travel from a private company or individual since 1 July 2013, and if so:

- (a) how many officers have accepted any hospitality, invitation to an event, free accommodation or free travel from a private company or individual;
- (b) what was the nature of the hospitality, event, free accommodation or free travel;
- (c) what is the name of the individual or private company that offered them;
- (d) what is the estimated individual value of the hospitality, event, free accommodation or free travel; and
- (e) on what date or dates did the hospitality, event, free accommodation or free travel occur?
