3509. Mr M. McGowan to the Minister representing the Attorney General; Minister for Commerce:

Could the Minister advise if the Minister and/or any staff member or placement within the Minister's Office, has had any contact or meetings with representatives of registered lobbyist Kreab Gavin Anderson (Australia) Ltd, since 1 July 2013, and, if yes:

- (a) what were the dates of the contact(s) or meeting(s);
- (b) what was the name of the client being represented during the contact;
- (c) what was the nature or subject of discussion during the contact(s) or meeting(s);
- (d) were other people present during the contact(s) or meeting(s); and
- (e) what were the names of all people present?

Between 1 July 2014 and 17 February 2015 the current Ministerial staff have had the following contact or meetings with representatives of Kreab Gavin Anderson related to government business.
