5081. Mr P.A. Katsambanis to the minister representing the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer the Minister to the Sorrento Primary School in the electorate of Hillarys, and ask:

- (a) How much has been budgeted for the removal of the existing ceiling in the school's North Block building;
- (b) How much has been budgeted for a new ceiling;
- (c) When will tenders for the removal of the existing ceiling be announced;
- (d) When did the department conduct an audit of the school's building and facilities;
- (e) What is the anticipated timeframe for removing the existing ceiling and building the new one;
- (f) Will the removal of the existing ceiling require an asbestos management plan; and
- (g) Are there any plans in the next 12 months for any other building or facility upgrades at Sorrento Primary School:
 - (i) If yes, please outline the nature of these works?

Mr P. Papalia replied:

- (a)–(b) An amount of \$71 567 has been budgeted for the replacement of nine ceilings in the North Block building as part of the \$18 million targeted maintenance program.
- (c) The contract was awarded on 9 April 2019.

- (e) The ceiling works will commence during Term 2, 2019 and are expected to take five days to complete. The commencement date will be discussed and agreed with the school principal.
