8854. Mrs M.H. Roberts to the Minister for Police

- (1) What is the full strength of fully sworn police officers in each of the policing districts?
- (2) How many fully sworn police officers were actually in each of the districts on 1 July 2012?
- (3) What is the full staffing level of each of the policing districts?
- (4) What is the breakdown of staffing in each district by position or level?
- (5) How many staff were actually in each of the districts on 1 July 2012?
- (6) For each other unit or section in WA Police, what is the full staffing complement by position or level?
- (7) For each of those same units or sections how many staff were there on 1 July 2012?
- (8) Are there any positions in WA Police that are not covered in (1) to (7)?
- (9) If so, what are the positions and where are they located?
- (10) How many of those positions were actually filled on 1 July 2012?

Mrs L.M. HARVEY replied:

- (6)–(7) The Western Australia Police advise due to operational sensitivities, specific information relating to staffing levels of individual Police Stations/Units is not released. Resources are principally allocated at a District/Divisional level and District/Divisional Superintendents deploy these resources within their District/Division to provide the best possible policing service to meet operational requirements and the varying needs of the community.
