Unfortunately, my question is not to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport!

I refer to question without notice 783 asked in the Legislative Council on Wednesday, 12 August 2015.

- (1) What was the occupancy rate for Government Regional Officers' Housing dwellings in Karratha in 2012, 2013 and 2014?
- (2) Fifty apartments in Pelago East were originally owned by the department. Were the 24 apartments that are no longer owned by the department sold?
- (3) If yes to (2), when?
- (4) If yes to (2), to whom?
- (5) If yes to (2), did the department make a profit from the sale of these 24 apartments?
- (6) If no to (2), what did the department do with the 24 apartments?
