- (5) How many teachers were employed teaching at Rangeview at this time?
- (6) How many juvenile custodial officers were employed at Rangeview at this time?
- (7) How many of these juvenile custodial officers were on sick or stress leave at this time?
- (8) How many psychologists were employed at Rangeview at this time?
- (9) How many nurses were employed at Rangeview at this time?

**Mr J.M. Francis replied:**

- (1) 55
- (2) 6
- (3) 9 (includes both remand and arrest status).
- (4) 40 (includes both remand and arrest status).
- (5) 3
- (6) 79
- (7) One on sick leave. There is no provision for “stress leave” under the Juvenile Custodial Officers’ Award.
- (8) There are 21 Psychologists employed to service youth population in custody and community. These resources are centrally located and deployed based on demand for services.
