

EAST PERTH COMMON GROUND PROJECT

202. Hon STEVE MARTIN to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Homelessness:

I refer to the government's signature homelessness policy, the East Perth Common Ground project.

- (1) How many responses have been lodged for the government's request for tender, which was reopened in November last year?
- (2) Have any of these responses been successful, and —
 - (a) if yes, when is construction expected to commence; and
 - (b) if not, why not?

Hon JACKIE JARVIS replied:

The Minister for Agriculture and Food represents the Minister for Homelessness.

Member, was that question lodged today?

The evaluation process is currently underway and the state government will announce the successful proponent once the evaluation process has been completed.
