- (1) Can the minister please provide the following information on Banksia Hill Detention Centre and unit 18, respectively, for March 2023
 - (a) the number of suicide and self-harm attempts;
 - (b) the monthly average out-of-cell hours; and
 - (c) the number of occasions on which a young person spent 20 or more hours in their cell?
