

CHILD DEATHS — OMBUDSMAN'S REVIEW

3736. Hon Sue Ellery to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Attorney General

- (1) How many investigatable deaths of children are currently being monitored and or reviewed by the Ombudsman's Office?
- (2) What is the date of the death of each the children subject to the above?

Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN replied:

- (1)-(2) I have been advised that as the Ombudsman's Office is an independent statutory authority which reports directly to the Western Australian Parliament, it would be more appropriate if the Honourable member asks her question directly to the Ombudsman.
