 - (f) 2000 to date?
- (2) How many of the 200 000 workplace agreements referred to in the Administrator's speech are current?
- (3) What percentage of the WA work force is covered by state workplace agreements?
- (4) How many public sector employees are currently employed under workplace agreements?
- (5) What percentage of the public sector work force does this represent?
