

PREMIER — THIRD PARTIES — RECORD KEEPING

1119. Hon BEN DAWKINS to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I will be short and sweet today.

- (1) Does the Department of the Premier and Cabinet keep records of correspondence and conversations between the Premier and third parties; and, if not, why not?
- (2) If so, where and how does the department store these records?
- (3) Does the department provide these records to the State Records Office; and, if not, why not?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

- (1)–(3) The Department of the Premier and Cabinet complies with all requirements of the State Records Act 2000 using the department’s record-keeping system, including for the provision of records to the State Records Office.
