

18 CONDICOTE LOOP — ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR OF TENANT

Petition

For the last three years we have endured escalating levels of anti-social behaviour, including loud music emanating from the house at all times of the day, constant foul, extremely offensive and abusive language from ALL members of the family and degrees of hygiene and sanitation (or more precisely a lack thereof), particularly at the rear of the house, which leave a great deal to be desired.
