

BANKSIA HILL DETENTION CENTRE — CELLS

1444. Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to the minister representing the Minister for Corrective Services:

I refer to Banksia Hill Detention Centre (BHDC), and I ask:

- (a) how many cells normally exist at BHDC to house young people;
- (b) as of May to-date, how many cells at BHDC are currently operational and fit to safely detain young people;
and
- (c) as of May to-date, how many cells at BHDC are currently offline or unsafe to detain young people?

Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

- (a) 220
- (b) 108
- (c) 112 – This number includes cells that are offline due to ongoing construction work.
