

GNANGARA PINE PLANTATION

578. Hon Dr BRAD PETTITT to the Minister for Forestry:

I refer to the native revegetation of the Gngangara pine plantation.

- (1) How many hectares have been revegetated and remain planted to date?
- (2) At what date or year does the state government expect the revegetated native plant seedlings planted in the Gngangara state forest will be mature enough to provide food supply for black cockatoos?

Hon JACKIE JARVIS replied:

- (1)–(2) Questions relating to the regeneration of the Gngangara pine plantation should be referred to the Minister for Environment.
