

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT — REQUESTS FOR REPRESENTATION

1307. Hon BEN DAWKINS to the minister representing the Minister for Planning:

I refer to yesterday's answer to question without notice 1293.

- (1) How many times has an aggrieved person made a representation to the minister under section 211(1)(a) of the Planning and Development Act 2005 during the past 12 weeks?
- (2) Last Thursday I emailed the minister the petition on the Binningup golf course estate, along with details of the 76 signatories and their email addresses. One line of the signed petition states, in part —

... we, as persons aggrieved under Section 211 making representations in this petition to the Minister for Planning ... to ... refer these representations to the SAT ...

Will the minister address this as 76 separate section 211 requests and get back to my constituents directly by email or would the minister like me to ask them to email the minister separately?

Hon JACKIE JARVIS replied:

The following response has been provided by the Minister for Planning.

- (1)–(2) As advised in the response to Legislative Council question without notice 1049, as the honourable member has notified the minister's office that he has lodged proceedings in the Supreme Court, it would not be appropriate for the minister to comment on this matter.
