

POLICE — PROTECTED ENTERTAINMENT PRECINCT LAWS

1424. Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to the minister representing the Minister for Police:

I refer to the Protected Entertainment Precinct laws, and I ask:

- (a) how many exclusion notices have been issued since the laws came into effect, broken down by precinct; and
- (b) how many in (a), were issued to a person who:
 - (i) identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander; and
 - (ii) indicated they had no fixed address or were otherwise un-housed?

Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

The Western Australia Police Force advise:

- (a) 14 have been issued of which 12 are from Perth/Northbridge, one from Mandurah and one from Hillarys.
- (b)
 - (i) Four of the above identify as Aboriginal.
 - (ii) One male person was considered street present but believed to have accommodation in Regional WA.
