I refer to the \$287 000 taxpayer-funded Ad Astra Consultants report to government canvassing options in relation to the insolvent and foreign-owned Griffin Coal.

- (1) When did the government receive the Ad Astra Consultants report and who or whom received it?
- (2) What were the five recommendations or solution scenarios canvassed in the report and has government endorsed any of the recommendations or proposals in the report?
- (3) What criteria has the government applied to value for money in the commissioning and delivery of the report?
- (4) Will the government table the report to the house; and, if not, why not?
