211. Hon NEIL THOMSON to the Minister for Finance:

I refer to the off-the-plan duty concession or rebate introduced by the Cook Labor government, which has had a budget of between \$3.1 million and \$18.2 million since 2021–22.

- (1) How many applications have been approved to date?
- (2) What is the dollar value of the concessions or rebates provided to the applicants to date?
- (3) What is the total anticipated value of the concessions or rebates when the scheme ends?
- (4) What is the total spend on software development related to this initiative to date?
- (5) How many FTE are currently required to process this rebate?
