

MAIN ROADS — ROUNDABOUTS

990. Hon Dr BRAD PETTITT to the minister representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to compact and mini roundabouts as part of Main Road WA's low-cost urban road safety program.

- (1) How many compact and mini roundabouts have been installed since this program began?
- (2) Has there been any evaluation of the program?
- (3) If yes to (2) —
 - (a) did this evaluation include impacts on pedestrian and cyclist safety; and
 - (b) will the minister table the evaluation outcomes?
- (4) If no to (2), when is an evaluation planned and will it include impacts on pedestrian and cyclist safety?

Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) Eight compact roundabouts and 16 mini roundabouts.
- (2)–(4) The low-cost urban road safety program has been evaluated as part of the Western Australian road research and innovation program and is currently being considered. Vulnerable road users were included.
