

KIMBERLEY FLOODS — TEMPORARY HOUSING

**384. Hon STEVE MARTIN to the minister representing the Minister for Housing:**

I refer to the recent floods in the north west of Western Australia.

- (1) How long does the government expect victims of floods to live in temporary housing?
- (2) Will the government please confirm a time line of when permanent housing can be expected to be contracted, commenced and completed?
- (3) How many stakeholders have engaged in consultation with the government as part of the permanent housing rebuild process?
- (4) Will the government please list the names of those contacted in (3) and the dates on which they were contacted?
