

BURU ENERGY LTD–TRANSBORDERS ENERGY — FLNG FACILITY — KIMBERLEY

1216. Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Mines and Petroleum:

I refer to this statement by Buru Energy Ltd in their latest Quarterly Report (Dec 2022), “As part of the continuing work on the commercialisation of the Rafael discovery, Buru entered into an agreement with Transborders Energy, to conduct a pre-feasibility study for a Kimberley-based compact marinised Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) plant solution.” and I ask: based on what Buru has advised the Department of Mining Regulation and Safety (DMIRS), or based on DMIRS own assessment, what route does DMIRS understand or expect any pipeline for the gas from Rafael to the floating LNG facility would take?

Hon Matthew Swinbourn replied:

DMIRS has not been informed, nor has DMIRS made any assessment of any proposed pipeline route.
