LEGAL AFFAIRS — JUSTICE PIPELINE MODEL

1021. Hon Nick Goiran to the minister representing the Treasurer:

I refer to the Attorney General's joint media statement with the former Treasurer made in September 2017 that announced the development of a justice pipeline model that was to come into effect mid-2018 and deliver a more efficient justice system, and I ask:

- (a) have any reviews, reports, modelling or similar documents been completed assessing or evaluating this model;
- (b) if yes to (a), will the Minister table those documents;
- (c) (c) if no to (a) or (b), why not; and
- (d) what has been the total cost of this model for the duration of the four years it has been in effect?

Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

- (a) No.
- (b) Not applicable.
- (c) The model is a financial tool used to inform funding deliberations by estimating the downstream impact of policy initiatives and future trends and demands on the justice system.
- (d) The model was established within its original project budget of \$850,000.
