

PINE PLANTATION — NANNUP

636. Hon STEVE MARTIN to the Minister for Forestry:

I refer to the recent decision of Nannup shire council to reject an application by the Forest Products Commission to create a large-scale pine plantation on vacant farmland.

- (1) Does the government intend to challenge the decision made by the local community?
- (2) How much money was paid for the land and for how many hectares?
- (3) Will the Nannup shire council decision impact the government's pine planting target for the 2023 season?

- (1) The Forest Products Commission is currently considering its options.
- (2) The property has not yet settled.
- (3) The FPC has new and existing areas to plant 3.3 million pine seedlings for the 2023 planting season.
