## MEMBER FOR KWINANA — UNFAIR DISMISSAL CASE

## 115. Hon NICK GOIRAN to the minister representing the Deputy Premier:

I refer to the decision of the Public Service Appeal Board on 5 January 2023.

- (1) Is the Deputy Premier aware that the senior commissioner found
  - ... it has not escaped our attention that as recently as 2 March 2020 the Minister's Chief of Staff had alerted the Minister to a suspicion that the Kwinana electorate office staff had excessive amounts of leave accrued and may not have consistently applied for leave that was being taken.
- (2) Who was the minister's chief of staff on 2 March 2020?
- (3) Was the chief of staff's alert delivered in written form?

## Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. The following answer has been provided to me by the Deputy Premier.

(1)–(3) The honourable member is referring to the matter regarding the employment of a former electorate officer. The former employee appealed to the Public Service Appeal Board contesting the termination of her employment. The matter was dismissed by the Public Service Appeal Board on 5 January 2023.
