

CYCLONE SEROJA — RECOVERY

1367. Hon Martin Aldridge to the minister representing the Minister for Housing; Lands; Homelessness; Local Government:

I refer to the Minister's media statements of 7 March 2022 and 16 August 2022 and question without notice 358 in relation to the construction of a multi-user workforce accommodation facility in Kalbarri, and I ask:

- (a) have contract negotiations concluded with Petra Westkey Modular Housing;
- (b) on what date was a contract executed;
- (c) please table the contract;
- (d) does the arrangement between the State Government and Petra Westkey Modular Housing result in the lease, sale or transfer of the land;
- (e) does the arrangement require the achievement of milestones by Petra Westkey Modular Housing;
- (f) if yes to (e), what are those milestones;
- (g) when will the 56-person facility be commissioned and available for use;
- (h) has the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) provided any support to the initiative; and
- (i) how many 'registrations of interest' were received for the Kalbarri land?

Hon Jackie Jarvis replied:

- (a)–(g) The State Government has fulfilled its commitment to identify and release Crown land to support the development of workers accommodation in Kalbarri.
Contractual negotiations between the State Government and Petra Westkey are ongoing.
- (h) The Registration of Interest process was released before Cyclone Seroja and is unrelated to the recovery effort.
