Petition

**HON MICHAEL MISCHIN (North Metropolitan** — **Parliamentary Secretary)** [3.12 pm]: I present a petition containing 13 signatures couched in the following terms —

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia assembled.

We the undersigned workers, resident and ratepayers of the City of Nedlands, while being strongly supportive of the concept of a Perth Waterfront Plan, are opposed to the current plan for the Perth Waterfront project as:

- the cutting of Riverside drive will have serious impacts on traffic congestion in and around the Perth central business district;
- as a result residents and business people of the Western Suburbs, including the City of Nedlands, will experience increased difficulty visiting central Perth;
- the said residents and business people will find it harder to travel to and from Perth Airport;
- the lengthy construction time of the project anticipated to be some 10 to 20 years, will result in continuous disruption and traffic congestion for the foreseeable future.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request that the Legislative Council inquire into these matters before any further work on this project commences.

And your petitioners as in duty bound, will ever pray.
