CLASSIC CARS — FEE REDUCTION SYSTEM

Petition

HON COLIN HOLT (South West) [2.08 pm]: I present a petition containing 309 signatures and couched in the following terms —

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled. We, the undersigned, support the Fee Reduction System as announced by the Transport Minister (January 18th 2020) but fully oppose the aspect that compels classic car owners to be members of an approved Car club to be eligible.

Our opposition is on the following grounds.

- We believe it should be accessible to all Western Australians whether they're members of a club or not.
- 2. We believe the majority of Classic Car, Modified Car & Street Rod Owners in regional WA are not able to join clubs let alone attend metro based club events with distances involved which mean rural people would be unfairly disadvantaged.
- 3. It also loads up extra administrative & organisational work on volunteer members of car clubs which can be avoided.

We, therefore ask the Legislative Council to:

- 1. Adopt a "90 days for \$90" style system with no club membership required.
- 2. Introduce the system with the driver to keep a Log Book of their maximum 90 days of road travel, with each trip filled in prior to leaving home, to be carried in the vehicle at all times to be presented to WA Police upon request.
- 3. Set penalties for owners who exceed their allotted 90 days and/or falsify or fail to fill in their log. And your petitioners as in duty bound, will ever pray.
