

CORRECTIVE SERVICES — PAROLE SUSPENSION

1431. Hon Nick Goiran to the minister representing the Minister for Corrective Services:

I refer to the role of Adult Community Corrections in suspending parole, and I ask:

- (a) how many parolees have had their parole suspended in the current financial year;
- (b) have any parolees had their parole suspended on more than one occasion;
- (c) how many parolees are currently the subject of return to prison warrants; and
- (d) further to , on what dates were those return to prison warrants issued?

Hon Stephen Dawson replied:

- (a) Between 1 July 2022 and 31 May 2023, 410 parolees had their parole suspended.
- (b) Between 1 July 2022 and 31 May 2023, of those 410 parolees, 26 had more than one parole suspension in the year.
- (c) Currently there are five parolees who are the subject of return to prison warrants.
- (d) Those five return to prison warrants were issued on; 10 May 2023, 19 May 2023, 22 May 2023, 26 May 2023, and 31 May 2023.
